Cooler weather is arriving. Please turn on your heat to make sure it is operating correctly before weather gets frigid. Also remember to disconnect all water hoses hooked up outside to keep the water lines from freezing.

HOLIDAY DECORATING

Decorating the home is a long-standing tradition around the holidays, but it is important to practice good safety habits when choosing decorations. In homes with small children, it is important to avoid holiday decorations that are breakable or contain sharp edges. Keep decorations with small parts out of the reach of children and avoid trimmings that look like candy or food, as they may attract extra attention from children. Every year, holiday lights should be tested for safety prior to use. If you choose to purchase new lights this year, look for a label indicating that the lights were independently tested for safety. Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections. Be sure to check the <u>Community Guidelines</u> for guidance on holiday decorations.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Most home fires start in the kitchen, and Thanksgiving is the leading day for kitchen fires in the US. Nearly four times the average daily number of kitchen fires occur on this holiday.

HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO AVOID THIS FROM HAPPENING IN YOUR HOME:

Stay in the Kitchen – never walk away, even for a short moment, while items are cooking on the stovetop, and never leave your home while food is cooking in the oven.

Use timers – Set a timer to remind yourself that the stove or oven is on.

Limit distractions – Avoid being distracted by guests, family, or other activities when actively cooking.

IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE, REMEMBER:

For a grease fire - Slide a lid over the pan to smother flames and turn off the burner. Do not use water on a grease fire.

For an oven fire - Turn off the heat and keep the door closed.
