As the hurricane/severe weather season approaches, we would like to provide bullet points to help you prepare. Prepare an Emergency Supply, making sure to include the following:

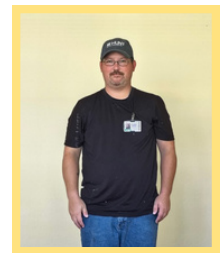
- Water and non-perishable food.
