



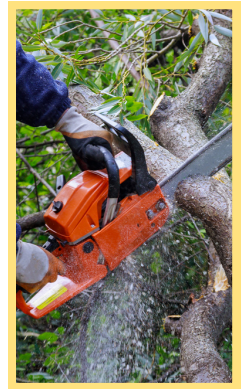

We want to thank all of the Families that attended Arnold's Resident Council meeting on Tuesday August 11th, 2026. We had 14 families from the community attend, along with members of AFCAC and JLL which oversees Air Force Housing Compliance. We had good conversations with residents about quality-of-life improvements they would like to see, in the future. We discussed the tree work that was completed the week of August 10-14, trimming up and cutting down trees that were dying and planted to close to infrastructure or homes. The crew did a good job cleaning up and grinding the stumps which enhanced our beautiful property.



The sidewalk and concrete work will begin around the second week in September and will take a few weeks to complete, weather permitting. Please make sure to talk with your children to stay away from the open areas where they are working as equipment will be in the area demoing the sidewalks and driveways that are being replaced. Total estimated time of completion should be before October 31, 2026, weather permitting.
